

Setting the Motto "*Your Covenant – Our Mission*" to Music

International Call for Proposals

The following CRITERIA apply for the presentation of compositions:

1. The setting of the motto should attempt to take the main languages into consideration: German, Spanish, English, Portuguese, French, Italian, Polish. However, it does not have to be submitted in all languages.

(Translation: cf. www.schoenstatt.org, keyword music2014)

2. In its basic form the motto must be able to be sung with very limited musical accompaniment.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Procedure

The following documents have to be submitted by applicants to **music@schoenstatt2014.org**:

1. The setting of the motto: "Your Covenant – our Mission" in its basic form, consisting of melody, text and chords, as well as an indication of tempo
2. At least a suggestion for an arrangement to be added.
3. The motto must be submitted
 - in writing
 - a demo version (mp3) is desirable.
4. A written declaration by the author that the motto has not been published or publicly performed, and that it will not be publicised before it has been published by Team 2014.

5. Closing date 19 March 2013

FURTHER GUIDELINES

- The winner will be decided by a jury in conjunction with the General Presidium and the Central Team 2014.
- The decision is final.
- The winner assigns all rights to the song to "Schoenstatt International 2014".
- The winner will receive a prize: a free participant's card for the jubilee events from 16-19 October 2014.
- "Schoenstatt International 2014" has the sole right to publish and market the song while acknowledging the author.

- By submitting an entry the author accepts the conditions of entry.
